Other Activities

Plant Commentary

At the monthly meeting a plant commentary on the orchids displayed on the night are described. This is of special interest to all members and provides an opportunity to learn more about species orchids, their habitat and method of cultivation, also the opportunity for growers to ask questions.

Spring Show

The Society conducts a Spring Orchid Species show in the latter half of each year at the Mt Coot-tha Botanical Gardens Auditorium where visitors can see hundreds of orchids from all over the world.

Plant Sales

Species Orchids are available for purchase at the monthly meeting and at the Annual Spring Show from members who wish to dispose of their excess plants. This provides an opportunity for all members to obtain plants to add to their collections at reasonable prices.

Field Trips

From time to time the Society organises field trips to other members bush houses and also to commercial nurseries.

Additional Activities

Pot out competitions is where every member receives a seedling plant out of a flask of the same cultivar and a prize is awarded to the first member to grow on and flower the orchid. From time to time other interesting activities are included.
